



Hershey Resorts Meetings and Group Events Fact Sheet

GUEST ROOMS: **Hershey Lodge** offers 665 guest rooms, including 15 suites. High post-and-beam ceilings, exposed stonework and comfortable furniture pay homage to Hershey's rural heritage. Each guest room and suite is appointed with regionally crafted furnishings and local artwork and offers convenient access to meeting rooms, restaurants and parking.

The Hotel Hershey is an elegant, Mobil Four-Star, AAA Four-Diamond property. The hotel offers 230 deluxe guest rooms and 29 suites, including The Milton S. Hershey Presidential Suite. Each guest room and suite is tastefully decorated in a Mediterranean theme and offers views of the formal gardens, the lushly planted front terrace or the town of Hershey in the valley below.

AND
SERVICES:**

As Pennsylvania's largest convention resort, **Hershey Lodge** offers more than 100,000 square feet of meeting, banquet and exhibit space. With three ballrooms and 34 meeting rooms, the Lodge can provide an appropriate venue for any banquet, conference or meeting. The Great American Hall is 32,000 square feet; is equipped for more than 1,000 telephone, T-1 and Ethernet connections; and can accommodate up to 210 8-by-10-foot exhibit booths. **Hershey Lodge** offers complete audiovisual, business center and convention services, as well as high-speed Internet access from all guest rooms, the Chocolate Ballroom and Confection Hall.

With more than 23,500 square feet of meeting space in 18 meeting rooms, **The Hotel Hershey** boasts an impressive range of facilities for a variety of functions – from a gala for 600 to a senior board meeting. Complete audio-visual services are available from a professional staff on site. Certified meeting professionals are on staff, and the Hotel offers team-building programs as well as communications training. In addition, the Hotel provides high-speed Internet services and an on-site business center.

Hershey Country Club offers more than 10,000 square feet of meeting space. The Keystone Ballroom, which can host up to 400 for a reception, offers panoramic vistas of the East and West courses in an elegant setting – perfect for a large function or other special event. The J. Weitzel Room, adjacent to the ballroom, is perfect for intimate events or smaller meetings, and it can host up to 100 for receptions. Located next to the clubhouse is the four-season Picard Grand Pavilion. Named for former head golf pro Henry Picard, it provides a scenic view of the East and West courses. This all-season pavilion provides a unique setting for banquet events or can serve as a centralized location for tournament activities. The club also has a fully staffed banquet department that can assist meeting planners.

SPA AND FITNESS: **The Spa At The Hotel Hershey** is a masterpiece for the senses. It provides total luxury in a sanctuary where chocolate is not just a sweet treat, but also a necessary ingredient for innovative spa treatments. The Whipped Cocoa Bath, Chocolate Bean Polish and Chocolate Fondue Wrap are just a few of the signature treatments at the Spa, with traditional treatments such as massages, hydrotherapy and facials also available. The Spa offers 53 treatment rooms in its 30,000 square feet, as well as a separate hair and nail salon and a Spa guest-only lounge and retreat.

A full fitness center offers personal training, a variety of exercise equipment and an indoor pool.

GOLF: Golf in Hershey is the ultimate sweet spot. Guests of **Hershey** Resorts have access to four golf courses, including two distinctive, 18-hole courses at **Hershey** Country Club. The legendary par-73 West Course dates to the early 1930s; the par-71 East Course was designed by George Fazio and opened in 1970. In addition, the nine-hole **Spring Creek Golf Course** is ideal for junior players. Wren Dale Golf Club, designed by the award-winning golf course architectural firm of Hurdzan/Fry of Columbus, Ohio, offers 18 holes of championship golf, as well as practice facilities including practice range with grass teeing area and chipping/putting areas.

Hershey Country Club has been ranked among *Golf Digest's* Top 50 resorts in the U.S. since 1999. Legendary golf heroes have graced Hershey's fairways, including former club pros and

World Golf Hall of Fame members Ben Hogan and Henry Picard, plus Byron Nelson, Jack Nicklaus, Arnold Palmer and Sam Snead. In May 2006 the Country Club completed a major renovation that included a new 43,000-square-foot, two-story clubhouse and a 6,500-square-foot, all-season entertainment pavilion that overlooks the finishing holes of both the East and West courses.
