



Hershey Golf Collection Fact Sheet

DESCRIPTION: The **Hershey** Golf Collection features 63 holes of golf on four courses. The West and East courses comprise **Hershey** Country Club. **Hershey** Links, acquired in 2007, is the newest addition to the Collection. Spring Creek Golf Course is a nine-hole course perfect for juniors, beginners and golfers seeking a shorter day on the greens.

The West and East courses are open only to Country Club members and to guests staying at **Hershey** Resorts. **Hershey** Links and Spring Creek are open to **Hershey** Country Club members, **Hershey** Resorts guests and daily-fee guests.

HISTORY: Golf started in Hershey in 1909, when Milton S. Hershey had a nine-hole course built between his chocolate factory and his home. In 1930, he commissioned Maurice McCarthy to design the West Course. McCarthy also designed the Juvenile Golf Club (now Spring Creek), which opened in 1932 as the first course in the country built specifically for children under age 18. Mr. Hershey's passion for the game led to World Golf Hall of Fame members Ben Hogan and Henry Picard each serving as club professional at **Hershey** Country Club.

FEATURES: Each course has a dedicated head professional and course superintendent. All courses feature clubhouses with instructional programs and pro shops. The Country Club and Links also offer full-service restaurants.
