- DESCRIPTION:** **Hersheypark**, a 110-acre theme park with more than 65 rides and attractions, features 11 roller coasters, more than 20 kiddie rides, live daily entertainment, games, food and shops. **The Boardwalk at Hersheypark** includes nine water-based attractions and combines the best of two favorite family vacations – a day at an amusement park and a trip to the beach.
- HISTORY:** Opened in 1907 by Milton S. Hershey as a picnic and pleasure grounds for his employees, in 1971 **Hersheypark** became a one-price admission theme park that is today among the most respected in the amusement industry.
- ADMISSION:** Regular (ages 9-54): \$52.95
Junior (ages 3-8): \$31.95
