



## Woodside Cottages At The Hotel Hershey Fact Sheet

**DESCRIPTION:** When it first opened in the 1930s, **The Hotel Hershey** offered cottages surrounding its main building. In 2009, as part of its Grand Expansion, the Hotel opened six 4-bedroom and four 6-bedroom Cottages.

These multi-bedroom guest Cottages offer all the luxuries of contemporary living. Design features reflect historical ties to design elements found in the Hotel's main building as well as its original cottages.

Guests of Woodside Cottages enjoy large bedrooms and sweeping views of the woods behind the Hotel. Each Cottage offers a private outdoor entrance, along with the luxurious amenities and professional service of **The Hotel Hershey**.

Parking spaces are available in front of each Cottage, and there is complimentary transportation service around the Hotel grounds. Upon check-in, all guests are escorted to their Cottage room by a Guest Services staff member, who provides an orientation about the room and Hotel services.

**NAMES:** Cottages are named for trees indigenous to the Hotel grounds:

- Beech
- Birch
- Cherry
- Dogwood
- Hemlock
- Hickory
- Maple
- Oak
- Pine
- Sycamore

**GREAT ROOMS:**

Guests have the option of renting individual bedrooms or reserving the entire Cottage, which includes a great room.

Upper-level great rooms feature cathedral ceilings, antique timber beams and a grand fireplace with hand-chiseled native Pennsylvania stone. A large dining table seats eight to 10 guests.

The lower great room at the six-bedroom Cottage is designed with fun and relaxation in mind and includes a classic card table that seats six.

All great rooms include a fireplace, flat-screen television, microwave, refrigerator/freezer and a sink at the wet bar. They also feature large French doors that lead out to a welcoming porch with casual seating.

**MEETING &

COTTAGE:**

This Cottage, named "Mountain Laurel," is located among the guest Cottages and provides corporate and social groups and professional associations with a convenient location that is deliberately removed from the activity of the main hotel. Mountain Laurel is noted for its privacy, staff attentiveness, and easy access to the restaurants and accommodations of the main Hotel.

**GREEN  
INITIATIVES:**

Each Cottage is pending LEED (Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design) certification. The United States Green Council created LEED as a rating system for "green building," which refers to design, construction and operation of buildings in an environmentally friendly way.

Included in the Cottages' certification are recycled roofing materials, native Pennsylvania stone, and geothermal heating and cooling systems. Guests also have the option to separate their trash into recycling.
