The Dish on Dining in Hershey: Some Delicious New Options for 2009



Opened in January, Café Zooka is located on the main level of The Hershey Story, The Museum On Chocolate Avenue. Named after one of Milton S. Hershey's first confections, Zooka is ideal for guests on the go as well as those who want to sit back and relax. It offers a nostalgic atmosphere and a variety of light fare, beverages, baked goods and creative desserts. Outdoor seating is available seasonally.

Located at a special "bar" within Café Zooka, the Countries of Origin Chocolate Tasting gives visitors the chance to enjoy warm drinking-chocolate samples. From fruity African chocolate flavors to Indonesian chocolate with caramel overtones, guests can hone their skills as cocoa connoisseurs . . . or simply enjoy a taste of indulgence from around the world. The tasting costs \$9.95.

DEVON SEAFOOD GRILL

Located on the first floor of the historic Hershey Press Building, located at 27 West Chocolate Avenue in downtown Hershey, Devon opened in April. The restaurant prepares fresh seafood from around the globe with imagination and style. Entrées vary, but on a typical day might include such items as seared Georges Bank scallops, Alaskan halibut, yellowfin tuna, South African rock lobster tail and Maryland-style jumbo lump crab cakes. Additional specialties include signature sweet drop biscuits and handcrafted cocktails. Fresh seafood is flown in six times a week from regional purveyors on the Atlantic and Pacific coasts, the Northwest and Hawaii, ensuring quality and freshness.

The Hershey location is the fourth Devon Seafood Grill restaurant. Other locations include Philadelphia, Chicago and Milwaukee. Hershey's Devon location seats 215 people, including two private dining areas (seating 14 and 24 guests) that are available on a first-come, first-served basis. The restaurant is open daily for lunch and dinner. Reservations are accepted and can be made by calling 717-508-5460.

HIGHLANDS *grill* AT HERSHEY LINKS

Set to open June 15, Highlands Grill is located in the new **Hershey** Links Clubhouse. Guests will enjoy an affordable menu, casual atmosphere and sweeping views of the beautiful **Hershey** Links golf course. Highlands Grill is conveniently located on Hanshue Road, off of Route 39 just outside of Hershey, and will welcome both golfers and the general public to enjoy authentic American pub fare complete with a full bar that boasts a “Cobra” beer tap. Highlands Grill will be open daily for lunch and dinner, and outdoor dining will be available seasonally.



Harvest, which is part of the “Grand Expansion” at **The Hotel Hershey**, is scheduled to open July 1. The restaurant will be located behind the Hotel, and the menu will focus on regional American cuisine. It will rely heavily on the use of local products from Lancaster County. The restaurant will also feature patio seating when the weather permits, a private dining room, and private meeting and function space on its second floor. Harvest will be open daily. Reservations can be made by calling 717-534-8800.

Located inside Harvest, an adults-only bar will include bar seating for eight guests and table seating for 26. It will feature a variety of beers and microbrews and a wine list with more than 35 selections. An adult game room, open to guests age 16 and older, will include pool tables and shuffleboard. A kid’s game room will feature video games.
