



Hersheypark Fact Sheet

- DESCRIPTION:** **Hersheypark** is a 110-acre theme park with more than 65 rides and attractions. It features 11 roller coasters, more than 20 kiddie rides, live daily entertainment, games, food and shops.
- NEW FOR 2009:** Two new attractions will debut at **The Boardwalk at Hersheypark: The SEAquel** – “The Shore,” a wave pool, and “Intercoastal Waterway,” a “lazy river.” Now featuring nine distinct water attractions, **The Boardwalk at Hersheypark** is included in the one-price admission to the Park.
- HISTORY:** Opened in 1907 by Milton S. Hershey as a picnic and pleasure grounds for his employees, in 1971 **Hersheypark** became a one-price admission theme park that is today among the most respected in the amusement industry.
- ADMISSION:** Regular (ages 9-54): \$51.95
Junior (ages 3-8): \$30.95
Senior (ages 55-69): \$30.95
Senior+ (ages 70 & older): \$20.95
Children (ages 2 & younger): Free
- BONUS:** One-price admission provides access to all the rides and attractions, The Boardwalk, and daily live entertainment. It also includes entry to **ZooAmerica** North American Wildlife Park, an 11-acre, walk-through zoo with more than 200 animals.
