



The Boardwalk at Hersheypark: The SEAquel Fact Sheet

DESCRIPTION:

The Boardwalk at Hersheypark, which opened during the Park's centennial season in 2007, is a tribute to the legendary beaches of the Northeast: Atlantic City, New Jersey; Coney Island, New York; Ocean City, Maryland; and Rehoboth Beach, Delaware. The area combines the best of two favorite family vacations – a day at an amusement park and a trip to the beach.

The area exceeded guests' expectations and everyone wanted more . . . more water and more Boardwalk. So for its 2009 season, **Hersheypark** will deliver *lots* more with **The Boardwalk at Hersheypark: The SEAquel**. The introduction of two new water attractions, "The Shore" and "Intercoastal Waterway," will give guests even more ways to cool down at **Hersheypark**.

With the addition of these two new attractions and the inclusion of two long-time favorites (**Roller Soaker** and **Tidal Force**), the five original attractions in The Boardwalk (Bayside Pier, Coastline Plunge, East Coast Waterworks, Sandcastle Cove and Waverider) will now expand to nine water-based attractions, making The Boardwalk's offerings comparable to a stand-alone water park.

Admission to the area is included in the one-price admission to **Hersheypark**.

Inside **Hersheypark** near Midway America and adjacent to **Fahrenheit**, the Park's newest roller coaster.
